Call for 28th Interamerican Scout Conference

Dear Friends in Scouting:

Please note the following:

Agreement 04/2021

The Interamerican Scout Committee approved changing the date of the XXVIII Interamerican Scout Conference to November 2022.

The Constitution of the Interamerican Scout Region, states in its **article 8, letter c)**:

Notice of an ordinary meeting of the Regional Conference shall be sent by the Regional Committee to all Member Organizations and Accredited National Scout Organizations by the Regional Committee through the Regional Office.

The notice shall be sent by e-mail, or other verifiable means, not less than six months in advance of the beginning of the Conference.

According to the foregoing, I am pleased to convene you at **the twenty-eight regular meeting of the Interamerican Scout Conference, which will be held in Ciudad del Este, Republic of Paraguay, between November 24th to 27th, 2022**, giving the opportunity to participate through virtual means to delegates and observers that prefer this option.

In accordance with the provisions of **article 6, letter a)** of the Constitution of the Interamerican Scout Region, each Member Organization of the World Organization of the Scout Movement, that is part of the Interamerican Scout Region, can authorize up to **a maximum of 6 Delegates**, making sure that, among those, youth are represented. Member Organizations may authorize a maximum of 6 observers that can attend virtually or in person.

In conformity with the provisions established in the Regional Constitution, guests from National Scout Organizations from other regions, members of governmental or non-governmental organizations, national or international, that have common interests with the Scout Movement, may also participate as observers. All of these must be invited by the Interamerican Scout Committee.

We remind Member Organizations that, pursuant to **article 8, letter i)**, of the Constitution of the Interamerican Scout Region, only those Member Organizations who are **up to date with their annual registration payment of fees to the World Organization of the Scout Movement and to the Interamerican Scout Region** can exercise **the right to vote** in the 28th Interamerican Scout Conference.


In the coming weeks, the Interamerican Support Centre and the Interamerican Scout Committee, together, will send a complete circular with information regarding accommodation costs, registration deadlines and all details that are necessary for Member Organizations to schedule their attendance.

The detailed agenda of the Conference will be determined by the Interamerican Scout Committee soon and, in accordance with the provisions of the Regional Constitution, the agenda will be sent in a time manner to all Member Organizations for their input and suggestions.

The 28th Interamerican Scout Conference will take place both in person and virtually, however, the Interamerican Scout Committee encourages National Scout Organizations to try to take advantage of the face-to-face modality to send a strong message of motivation and reactivation of face-to-face activities to all members of Scout Movement in the Interamerican Region.

We thank you for giving this call the widest promotion and for starting your preparations so we can achieve the greatest possible representation of our Member Organizations in the Conference to be held in Ciudad del Este, Paraguay. We ask you to let us know, as soon as possible, the exact number of people who will participate in person on behalf of your National Scout Organization. This will allow us to properly plan the Conference and make efficient use of available resources.
